



Techniques: basic fabrics

We offer many plain fabrics and fabrics with woven designs. They come in a wide variety of material and weight. These fabrics do not require embroidery or application, but ornamenting techniques are possible on these fabrics.

The Pius fabric is very popular for lower budget paraments and lightweight vestments. The Pius fabric can also be combined with the Elias fabric, which is used for the Assisi collection.

The Linus fabric is also a very nice lightweight fabric, with gold and coloured lines.

The Dupion fabric is somewhat heavier and comes in many different colours, it is therefore a great alternative for customers who are looking for flexible options.

The Melchior fabric is known in association with Pope Jean-Paul II, who loved wearing a vestment in this fabric on several occassions.

Brugia is the only fabric that is made of 100% wool. Wool breaths very well, but it is somewhat more difficult in maintenance.

Most of our fabrics therefore are a mix of natural and man-made fibres. This guarantees an easy care approach, while maintaining the beauty of the natural fibres.




Techniques: machine embroidery

We have three unique embroidery machines in our workshop. Two of them are unique in Europe because of their large embroidery field, enabling us to embroider almost the entire shape of a chasuble, up to 145 cm (57") x 145 (57") cm, in one run. The advantage of machine embroidery is the speed of embroidery and the ability to embroider small details.

The punchcards are always made in-house. This allows us to be very flexible and to focus on the quality of the embroidery at all times.

Machine embroidery is perfect for larger series of paraments with the same design and for smaller and/or detailed designs. Because of the need of a punchcard that needs to be programmed by our embroidery expert, large designs are not budget friendly in this technique due to the many hours needed to make the punchcard. We recommend the application technique for large designs.









Techniques: application

This technique is propably most related to Slabbinck since the 1970's. It is a great technique allowing us to make large designs easily. Once the design is made and printed on our plotting machine, the pieces of fabric used for the design are cut out by hand in our workshop. Just like a mosaic, the pieces of fabric are put together to create the design. The application is finished with embroidery, so that the feel and look of the design is that of an embroidered piece.

It is not possible to work very detailed with the application technique, but larger designs are easily made. Since it is all done by hand, one single piece can be finished in this technique. We mainly use application for lectern and altar covers, tapestries and banners. But vestments of course can also be manufactured using this technique.



Techniques: hand embroidery

We have a standard collection of handembroidered emblems and bandings in stock for fast deliveries. When a design is not in stock, we do require 3 to 4 months delivery time for hand embroidery, since this technique is very time consuming and labour intensive.

We only use the best yarns for hand embroidery, ensuring a beautiful result. The great advantage of hand embroidery is that it is highly customazible. One piece can easily be finished in this technique and we will gladly help to create the perfect design for your customer if the design is not in our collection yet.

Since there are many techniques for hand embroidery (couching, mylar, frissé cannetille, etc.), we will gladly assist you in picking the best hand embroidery technique for your project, guaranteeing the satisfaction of your customer.

Techniques: digital printing

When your customer provides you with a high-resolution picture of an image he would like to see on any parament, we will gladly assist you.

Digital printing allows us to print any image on a polyester fabric so that one vestment or set of paraments can easily be manufactured using the image. The great thing about digital printing is that the image or design may be very complex, detailed and have diverse shades of colours.

We mainly use digital printing for banners, but also love working with printed bandings or emblems or even chasubles can be printed digitally (f.ex. our Brody Neuenschwander collection).

When a large quantities of vestments is required, digital printing can also be a budget friendly solution and allows fast deliveries.

























Techniques: combinations


There is 1 meter / 1 yard minimum charge. The necessary fabric is added to the altar cloth (style **63**), to compensate for shrinkage during the first launderings. Due to variables in laundering (water temperature, chemicals in detergents, etc.) the fabrics may shrink more or less than anticipated. Therefore, all altar cloths are provided with large $1\frac{1}{2}$ mems to be adjusted if necessary.

The front and back drop of type IV, are always attached by seams to the altar cloth for this reason there is an extra charge of 10 %.
